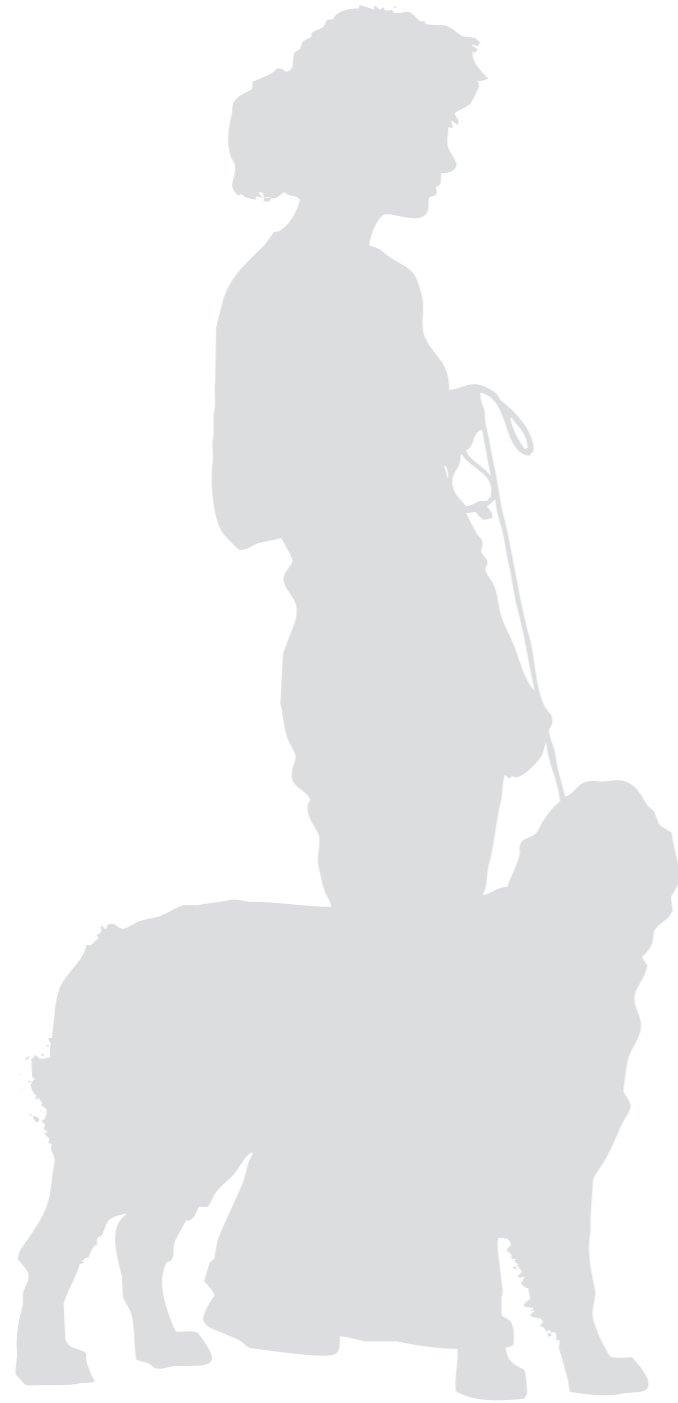

Frame

Fingers carry up to 3 lines of directional information. Accoya or solid oak panels carry surface etched graphics to create a de-bossed effect with a burnt timber finish with opportunity to paint in fill graphics and create a contrasting finish.
